## **CRISIS INTERVENTIONS IN SOCIAL WELFARE INSTITUTIONS**

#### **Research problem**

- A population of children and adolescents becoming more and more difficult.
- The specific characteristics of children and adolescents in social welfare institutions often lead to challenging crisis situations
- Educators need to have the right skills to intervene effectively
- An unexplored area of crisis intervention competences in Slovenia



# **RESEARCH SAMPLE**

#### **Quantitative part of the research**

- Author-designed questionnaire
- 154 educators, 56.8% of the population
- We looked at the frequency, intensity and complexity of crisis situations






# **RESEARCH SAMPLE**

#### **Qualitative part of the research**

- Semi-structured interviews were conducted in all social welfare institutions (expert centres for residential care) in Slovenia
- 46 participants (head teachers, teachers and counsellors) took part.
- Experts from German and Slovenian academic circles.



## INTERVENING EFFECTIVELY IN SPECIFIC CRISIS SITUATIONS



#### PROPOSAL FOR EFFECTIVE INTERVENTION IN CASE OF AGGRESSION/VIOLENCE

Zero tolerance to violence

Physical Rapid restraint reaction and and calming protection and of removal participant from s and dangerous bystanders situations

Activating colleagues and informing the authorities

Deescalation and relaxation techniques Protocol instead of report (minors) or report to police (over 15 years)

Pedagogica I treatment and conversatio n






