CHILDCARE REFORM IN BULGARIA

Guiding principle:

The family is the best environment for every child

Strategies for the transition from institutional care to care in the community: Long-term National Strategy "Vision for DI of childcare in Republic of Bulgaria" 2010 - 2025 and Action Plans for 2010 – 2016 and 2016 - 2025

Participation of the civil society:

NGOs in the Monitoring Committee and relevant WGs

The greatest success is the improved quality of life of children.



RESULTS OF THE REFORM

Adoption of the National Strategy "Vision for the DI of childcare in Bulgaria" 2010-2025 and first Action Plan 2010 - 2016

All institutions for children with disabilities are closed (till the end of 2015)
All institutions for children deprived of parental care are closed (till the end of 2020)

From 241 services in 2010 to 750 services in 2024, covering more than 20,500 children and families 3 Homes for Medico-Social Care for children about to be closed

OTHER IMPORTANT RESULTS

The Social Services Act:

- The provision of residential care for children up to 3 years is not allowed
- Measures for prevention of abandonment, reintegration into a family, adoption and foster care strengthened
- Improving the quality of life of children removed from specialized institutions
- Integrated approach in early childhood development services
- Support to children with disabilities financial support, day care and home-based services






CHALLENGES

- More children and parents supported through:
- ✓ Prevention and early intervention
- ✓ Information and counselling
- ✓ Therapy and rehabilitation
- ✓ Training and skills development







Target groups

- Children in alternative care
- Children with disabilities
- Children in precarious family situation
- Refugee and migrant children

Measures

- Prevention of risks
- More children in a family or family-based care
- Early intervention
- Support to young people leaving care



Key Activities

- ✓ Health promotion
- ✓ Patronage care for children from 0 to 3 years
- ✓ Early childhood development services
- ✓ Health and social services
- ✓ Counselling and mediation re: labor market



Main Objectives

- √ 40 000 children and their families will be supported
- ✓ Almost 7,500 children already have been supported
